IMPORTANT NOTICE!

Dear Tenants / Visitors

Welcome to **Rørvig Park!**

Rørvig Park consists of 51 privately and individually owned holiday homes – and we live close to each other. In order for us all to have a pleasant stay, we have a few rules which we all must observe.

Tenants - as well as owners - must respect the right of other residents' and any neighbours' privacy and right to quiet enjoyment during their stay in Rørvig Park

The pool may be used between 7 am and 10 pm. During your stay at the pool, you must always be considerate towards other residents. Small children must wear tight-fitting swim nappies when bathing in and playing at the pool.

Ball games and other outdoor activities must not disturb or cause any inconvenience to the other residents.

Excessive or unacceptable noise which disturbs other residents will not be tolerated.

The house owner is responsible for reimbursing Rørvig Park Association for the cost of any damage, which a tenant causes to the properties or premises of Rørvig Park.

Garbage and kitchen waste must be placed in the waste containers in closed plastic bags. Empty bottles/glasses are put in the bottle container. Ash and cinders from the grill/wood stove must not be placed in the waste containers until the next day, and only after water has been poured on the ashes.

It is not allowed to put up tents, motor caravans or mobile homes on the premises without the prior written acceptance from the Committee.

After using garden furniture, water toys and the like, it must be cleared away daily so that the area is nice and tidy at all times.

Cycling is only allowed on the asphalt surfaces.

Parking is only allowed in the marked bays.

We refer to the full set of "House Rules for Rørvig Park" (Husorden for Rørvig Park).
